SUBJECT: Summer 2007 Enrollment Analysis

DATE: September 4, 2007

The final summer 2007 enrollment total of 16,007 represents a 402 student (2.4%) decrease from summer 2006 figures. Undergraduate enrollment decreased by 518 students (4.9%). Graduate enrollment (including Special Professional) increased by 116 (2.0%). (See attached table).

Undergraduate Students

New undergraduate enrollment decreased by 60 students (6.0%). Enrollment of regularly admitted freshmen decreased slightly by 12 (9.3%) as did the number of students in the Summer Freshman Admits program 32 (4.3%). Transfer student enrollment decreased by 16 (13.2%).

Undergraduate enrollment decreased for continuing students by 379 (4.2%), re-entering students by 56 (15.3%), and for transient students by 23 (9.5%).

Undergraduate student enrollment increased for African American students by 65 (11.9%), foreign by 19 (6.9%), Hispanics by 11 (0.7%), and American Indians by 4 (8.9%). Enrollment decreased for Whites by 468 (7.6%) and Asian Americans by 163 (8.8%). There were 63 undergraduate students for whom ethnicity was not known.

Graduate Students

At the graduate level, enrollment (excluding Special Professional) decreased for continuing students by 1 (0.0%) and new graduate students by 34 (10.3%). However, re-entering students increased by 6 (9.0%).

Graduate enrollment (including Special Professional) increased for American Indians (2 or 8.3%), African Americans (11 or 6.6%), Asian Americans (35 or 9.1%), Whites (59 or 1.9%), and Hispanics (88 or 18.4%). Enrollment decreased for foreign students by 42 (2.7%). There were 109 graduate students for whom ethnicity was not known.

Enrollment by Residency

The percentage of Texas residents enrolled increased slightly from 77.0% to 77.1% and foreign students increased from 11.0% to 11.2%. Out-of-State students decreased from 11.9% to 11.8%.

Semester Credit Hours

Total semester credit hour (SCH) production decreased by 2,327 hours or 2.4%. SCH production decreased at the undergraduate level by 2,062 hours or 3.0%, doctoral by 272 hours or 2.8%, and Pharm. D. by 69 hours or 3.4%. SCH production increased at the master's level by 51 or 0.4% hours and Law by 25 hours or 1.6%. Average courseloads increased at the undergraduate, master's, and Pharm. D. levels, but decreased for doctoral and Law.

In summary, total student enrollment decreased. At the undergraduate level, there were decreases in continuing, re-entering, and transient students. Graduate enrollment decreased for all categories except re-entering students. University-wide, the proportional representation of White and Asian American students decreased. There was a significant increase in the proportion of Hispanic and African American students. Semester credit hour production decreased at all levels except for master's and Law, and average courseloads decreased at all levels except undergraduate, master's, and Pharm. D.
