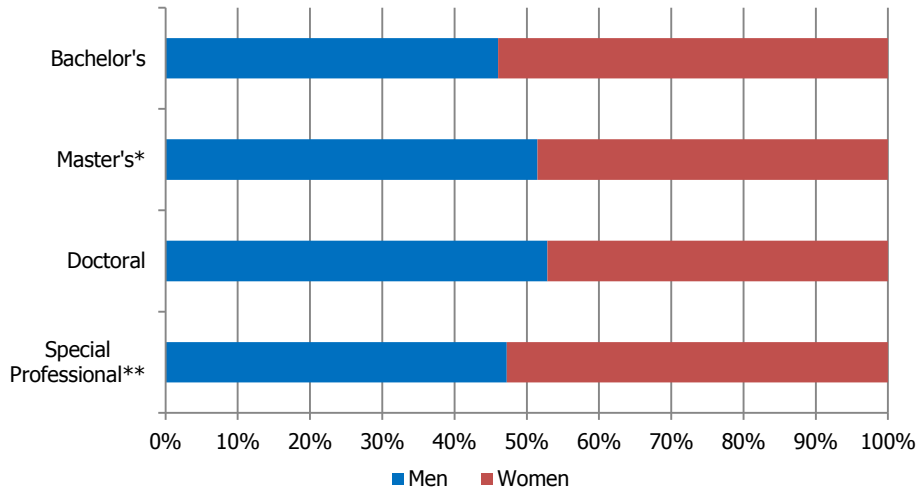


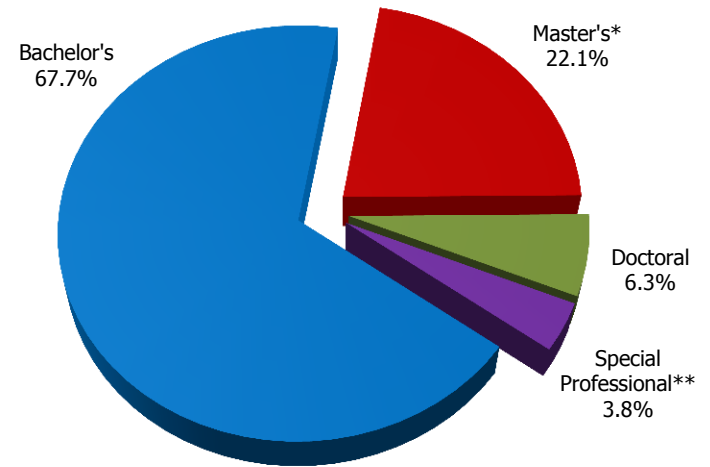

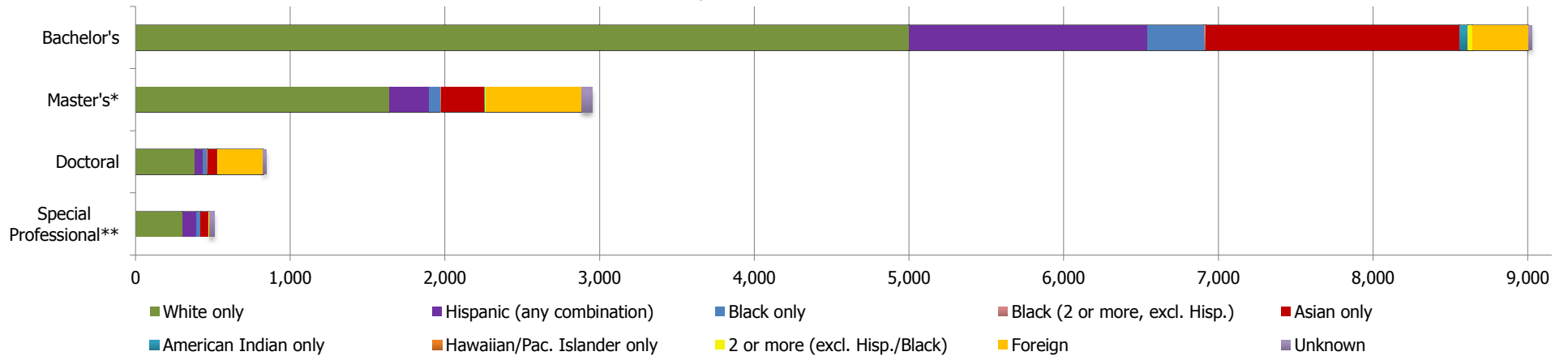
DEGREES CONFERRED BY LEVEL AND GENDER

GENERAL ANALYSIS – DEGREES CONFERRED

The following new degree programs were added since fall 2010: Master of Arts (MA) degree in African and African Diaspora Studies, Master of Fine Arts (MFA) degree in Creative Writing, Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree in Middle Eastern Languages and Cultures, Master of Arts (MA) degree in Middle Eastern Languages and Cultures, and Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) degree in Middle Eastern Languages and Cultures within the College of Liberal Arts (Table D 1).

A total of 13,332 degrees were awarded by The University of Texas at Austin in 2010-11, an increase of 117 (0.9%) from the previous year. The number of bachelor's degrees awarded increased by 75 or 0.8%. The number of master's degrees awarded increased by 44 or 1.5%. The number of Master of Laws (LLM) degrees awarded increased by 8 or 20.5% and the number of doctoral degrees awarded increased by 3 or 0.4%. In the Special Professional category, PharmD degrees awarded decreased slightly by 4 or -3.3%, Law (JD) degrees decreased by 10 or -2.6%, and AuD degrees increased by 1 or 12.5% (Table D 4).

Of the total number of degrees, 52.3% were awarded to women. Women earned 54.0% of the bachelor's degrees, 48.3% of the master's degrees, 47.2% of the doctoral degrees, 100.0% of the AuD degrees, 61.7% of the LLM degrees, 68.4% of the PharmD degrees, and 46.9% of the JD degrees (Table D 4).

Bachelor's degrees awarded, grouped by ethnicity/race, were as follows: 55.4% of the degrees for 2010-11 were awarded to White Only, 18.2% to Asian Only, 17.1% to Hispanic (any combination), 4.1% to Black Only, 4.0% to foreign students, 0.6% to American Indian Only, 0.3% to 2 or more (excl. Hisp./Black), 0.1% to Black (2 or more, excl. Hisp.), and less than 0.1% to Hawaiian/Pac. Islander Only (Table D 3).

The five largest degree producing colleges for 2010-11 were Liberal Arts (3,276), followed by Business Administration (1,958), Natural Sciences (1,958), Engineering (1,718), and Communication (1,449) (Table D 2).

The College of Liberal Arts awarded thirty-two percent of the total bachelor's degrees, followed by Natural Sciences (18.5%), Communication (13.5%), Business Administration (11.8%), and Engineering (11.5%). Two schools awarded nearly forty-six percent of the master's (includes LLM) degrees: Business Administration (29.6%) and Engineering (16.1%). Nearly forty-four percent of all doctoral degrees were awarded by Engineering (23.9%) and Natural Sciences (19.8%) (Table D 3).

Asian Only students (18.2%) and Hispanic (any combination) students (17.1%) were well represented among those students receiving bachelor degrees. Foreign students were well represented among those receiving graduate degrees, with 21.0% of master's (includes LLM) degrees and 34.7% of doctoral degrees awarded (Table D 3).

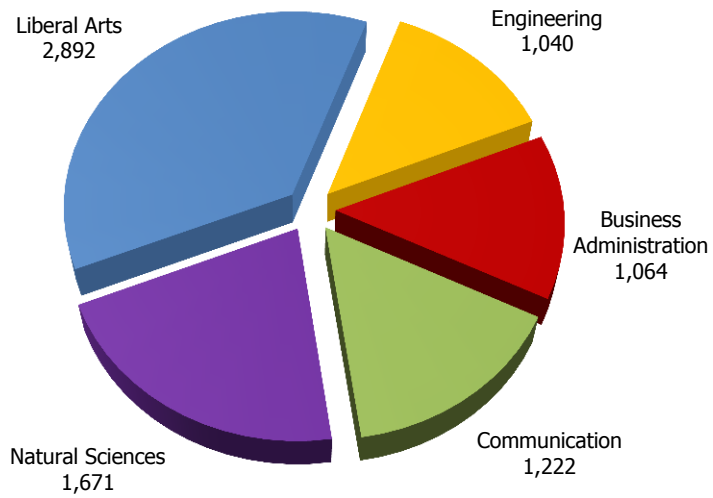

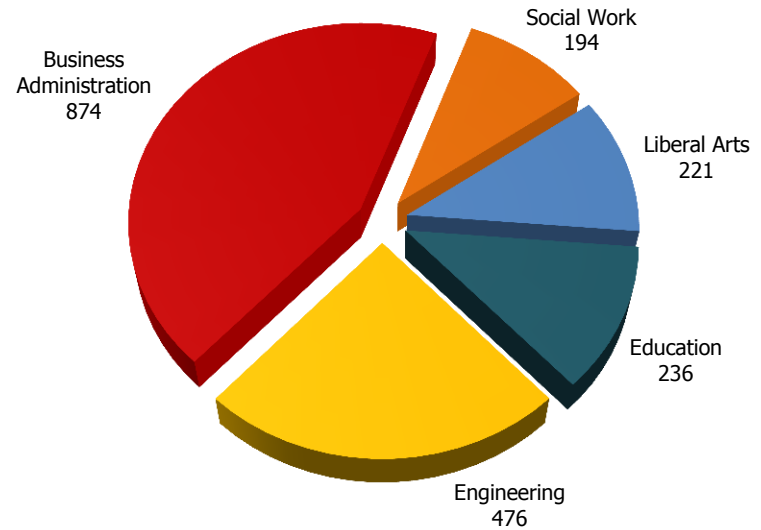

ACADEMIC YEAR 2010-2011**

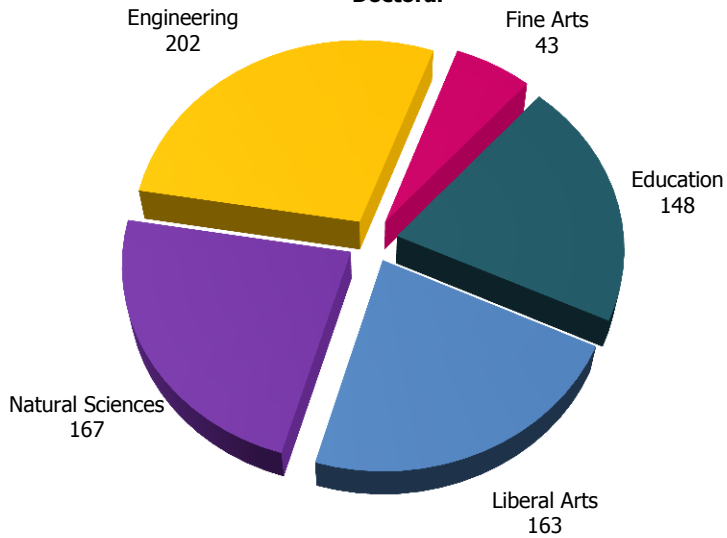

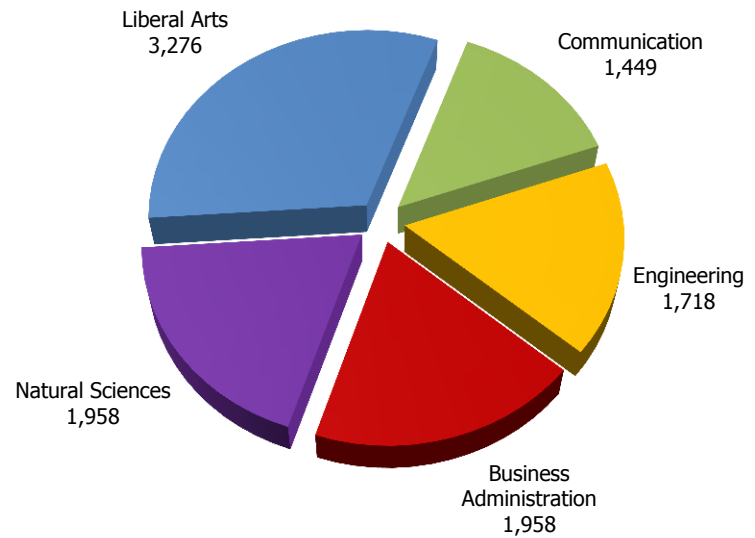
