GENERAL ANALYSIS – FACULTY/STAFF

For the academic year 2011-12, departmental appointed full-time equivalent (FTE) faculty decreased to 2,362.91, a -0.9% change from 2010-11 (Table FS 1). Teaching staff for 2010-11 (the latest year's data available) decreased to 3,780.46 FTE, a -6.2% change from 2009-10 (Table FS 2).

Overall, there were 1,433.53 or 60.7% full-time equivalent (FTE) faculty who were tenured, 387.01 or 16.4% who were tenure track, and 542.37 or 23.0% who were nontenure track (Table FS 3).

Table FS 4 shows that in 2011-12 UT Austin's average faculty salaries increased for all categories. The average salary for professors increased the most from \$136,405 to \$140,726, an increase of 3.2% from 2010-11. **Additional faculty salary information can be found on our website at <http://www.utexas.edu/academic/ima/> under the Statistical Handbook link.**

Table FS 5 compares UT Austin's average faculty salary for professors, associate professors, and assistant professors with average salaries from our expanded comparison group of institutions (made up of 20 institutions, both public and private). A complete list of these institutions can be found in Tables FS 5 and in the "Terms and Definitions" section. For 2010-11, UT Austin's average faculty salary for professors, associate professors, and assistant professors was below the average of our expanded comparison group institutions.

The total number of teaching faculty (including AI's and TA's) for fall 2011 decreased by 12 (-0.4%), with female teaching faculty increasing slightly by 1 (0.1%) and male teaching faculty decreasing by 13 (-0.7%) (Table FS 6).

Proportionally, Black (2 or more, excl. Hisp.) represent 0.2% of the total faculty, 2 or more (excl. Hisp./Black) 0.3%, American Indian Only 0.4%, Black Only 3.6%, Hispanic (any combination) 6.9%, Asian Only 9.4%, and White Only 79.1% (Table FS 7).

Among all teaching faculty for fall 2011, 51.1% were tenured, 14.0% were tenure track, and 34.9% were nontenure track (Table FS 8).

The student/faculty ratio increased slightly from the previous academic year. The student/faculty ratio for 2011-12 was 19.15, up from 18.86 in 2010-11 (Table FS 9).

The student/teaching staff ratio (includes TA's and AI's) for 2010-11 (the latest year's data available) was 11.90, up slightly from 11.15 in 2009-10 (Table FS 10).

Table FS 12 shows that in fall 2011, there were 12,601 full-time and 10,355 part-time (Less than 50% time) faculty and staff employed at The University.

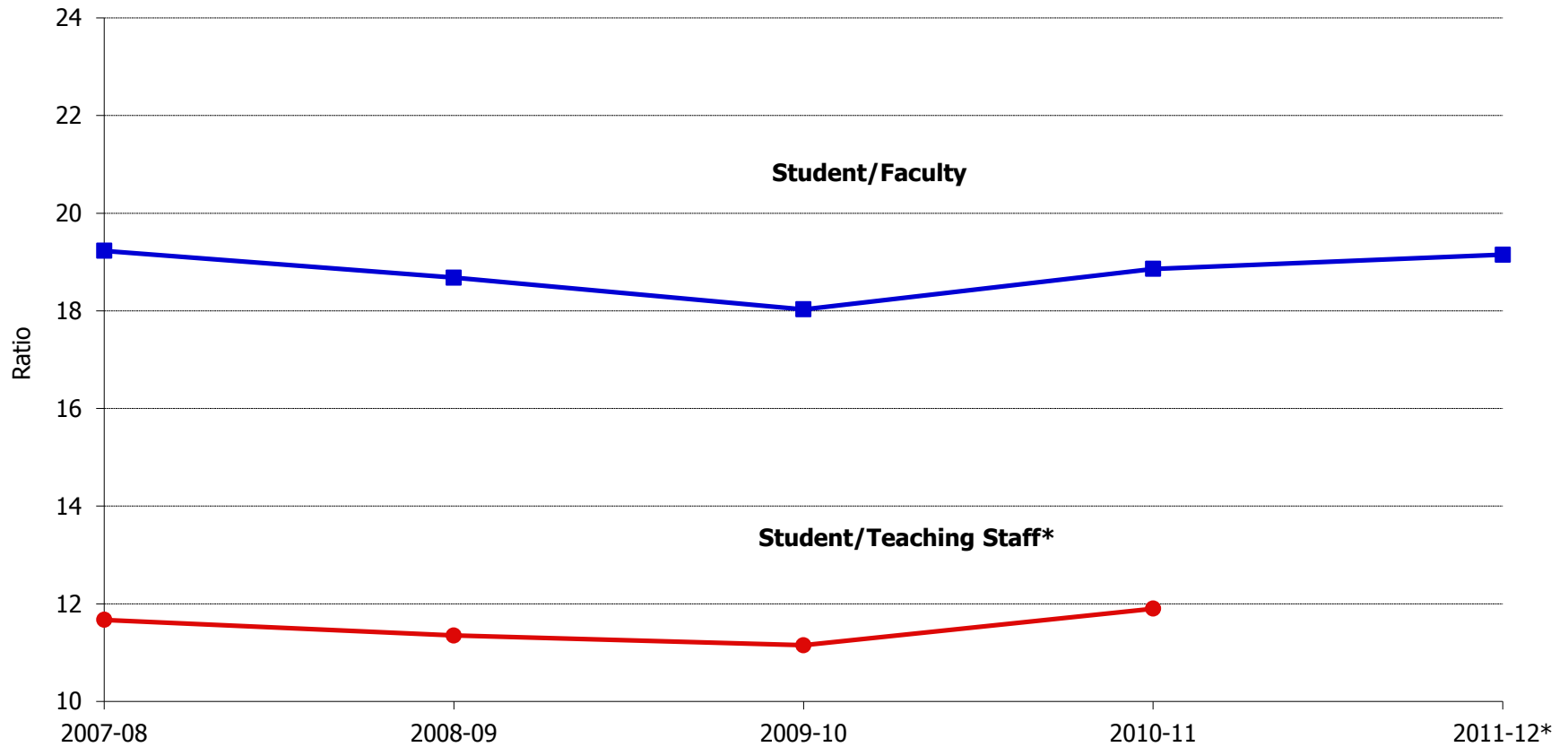
