

Number and Percent of Entering Freshmen with AP, CLEP, and IB Scores by Fall Semester 1999-2007

Table 1 presents the number of AP, IB, and CLEP test scores processed by DIIA Instructional Assessment and Evaluation and those scores eligible to receive credit for freshmen for a given fall semester from 1999-2007.

Please note that the term “credit eligible” refers to students who have scores that would allow them to receive credit whether or not they actually put the courses onto their transcript. For hours to be reported, students must petition for their eligible credit. Students have ten years from the time they take an exam to petition for the credit. Un-petitioned credit is in a pending status until the student “claims” it or the ten-year limit is reached.
