What should you do when the Garage Signage says "GARAGE FULL"?

You can still enter by using your Campus Club Card or your Parking Access Card!

What's up with the designated spaces on the Lower Level (LL) of the parking garage for certain types of vehicles?

The designated spaces support the university's sustainability goals and comply with LEEDs requirements for certification. By reserving spaces for hybrids and carpool cars the voluntary reduction of gasoline use is encouraged. Furthermore, it enhances guest's safety by discouraging the use of the LL entry to the Lower Lobby. Pedestrians in this area must cross driving lanes to use this entry which we would prefer to avoid. Please consider exploring and using the P1 and P2 garage levels where there are usually plenty of available spaces. Use the appropriate elevator to go directly to the lobby adjacent to your destination.
