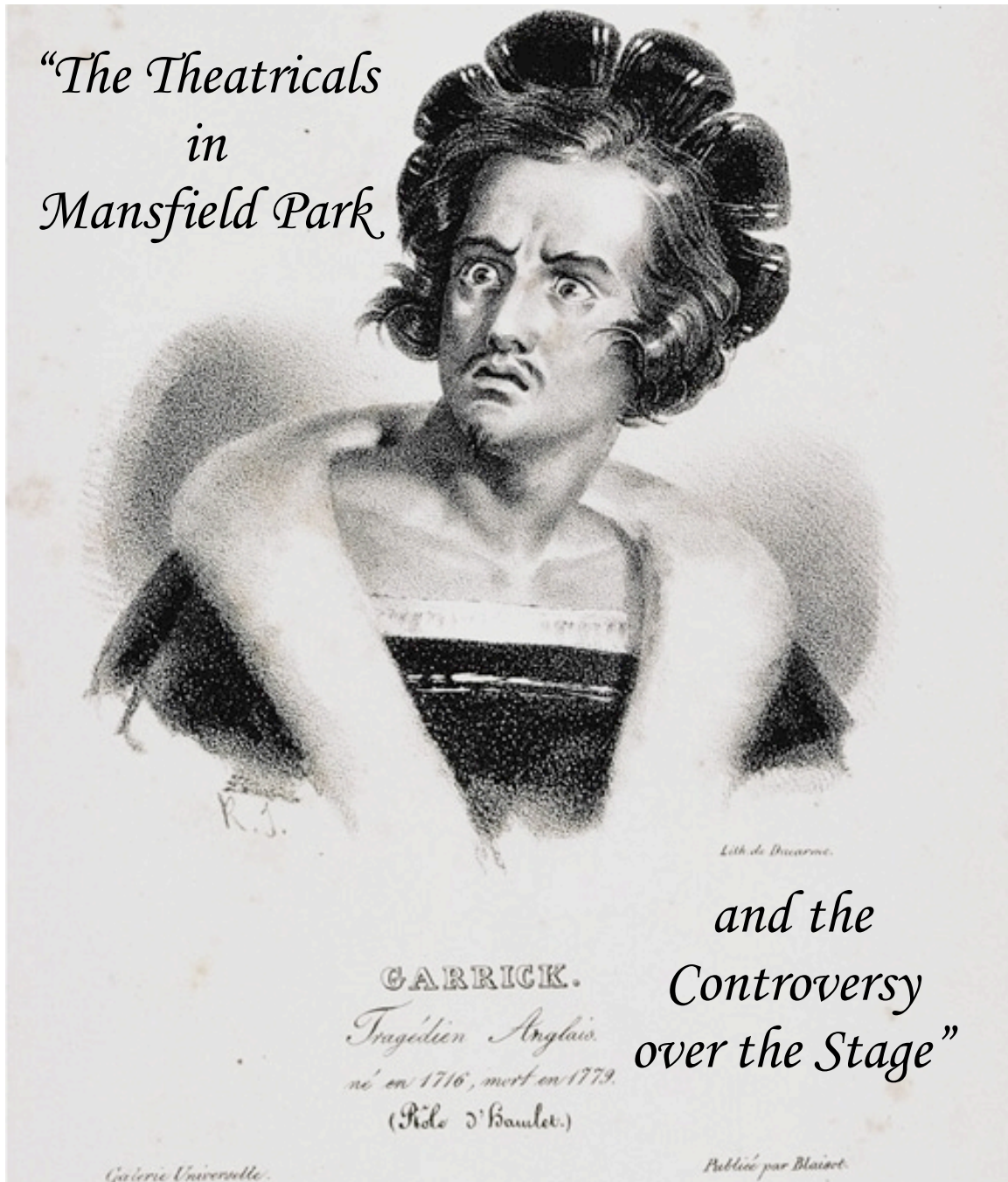

Professor Harris is an internationally-known Jane Austen scholar, who recently retired from her professorship at the University of Otago, New Zealand, only to make a mockery of the word “retirement.” Her most recent book is *A Revolution Almost Beyond Expression: Jane Austen’s Persuasion* (Delaware, 2007), which has been widely reviewed in enviable terms. She is also editor of the Oxford edition of Samuel Richardson’s *Sir Charles Grandison* (Oxford World’s Classics, 1972, repr. 1986 & 2001) and author of half a dozen other books, including *Samuel Richardson* (Cambridge, 1987) and *Jane Austen’s Art of Memory* (Cambridge, 1989).
