

Worksheet for Post-Prelims Coursework

The minimum requirement for coursework past the core requirements is 10 courses, split into two focus areas that the student defines in consultation with the Graduate Advisor, the student's Supervising Committee, and his/her potential Ph.D. supervisor.

Use this worksheet to evolve a plan for that coursework, and to record agreements made with the Graduate Advisor (e.g. about courses transferred in from other institutions that could not count toward the M.A., but which can for the Ph.D.). You may, in some cases, use electives from the M.A./core program as part of this count.

When you file for Ph.D. Candidacy, hand a filled-out copy of this form to the Graduate Advisor and GSC Chair along with the forms that they need to sign; this will make their review of your completed program easier.
