Workshops and Trainings **

- Sexism: It Still Exists (one hour)**
Provides an introduction to how sexism affects men and women in today's society.
- LGBT Identities: The Basics (minimum of one hour) ****
Covers definitions, policy issues, and the lived experiences of lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender individuals and communities.
- Ally Toolkit: Resources to Support LGBT Individuals (two hours)**
Offers an introduction to LGBT identities, heterosexism, and campus climate issues. Gives resources and tools to support LGBT individuals on campus and beyond.
- Ally Toolkit in Action: Practice Using Your Tools (one and one-half hours)**
Provides an opportunity to use tools through scenarios and role-playing. *Prerequisite: Previously attending "Ally Toolkit: Resources to Support LGBT Individuals" workshop.*
- Bisexuality: Discuss The Rarely Discussed "B" in LGBT (one hour)**
Explores bisexual identity -- the myths and realities. Also discusses how to be an ally and challenge biphobia.
- Transgender Identities: Expanding Concepts of Gender (minimum of one hour)**
Explores identities under the transgender umbrella and the complexities of gender identity and expression.
- Religion and Sexual Orientation: Obstructions and Intersections (one hour)**
Facilitates discussion around these often-taboo topics. Explores how religions affect the journeys of LGBT people.
- Movies as Learning: Watch, Discuss, and Learn (2 to 3 hours)**
Investigates a LGBT and/or women's topic through film. Choose a film from the list on the GSC website. The facilitator will come with the film and discussion topics and questions.
- Coalition Building: Stop "Divide and Conquer" (one hour)**
Explore the power of working around issues and not identities. Learn techniques for working across identities to make change.

**** Peers for Pride: Acting for Change**

The GSC now has a peer facilitation program. Peer facilitators and the Education Coordinator co-facilitate the "LGBT Identities: The Basics" workshop. The peer facilitators perform monologues on LGBT identities and facilitate dialogue in character.
