Enclosed is a motion by the Faculty Council to change the degree requirements for all undergraduates at The University of Texas at Austin (viz., Documents of the General Faculty 5189-5190, "Natural Science Requirement of the Core Curriculum for All Undergraduate Students at UT Austin"). This proposal (which complements Documents of the General Faculty 5155-5163, "Final Version of the Amended Motion to Change the Degree Requirements for all Undergraduate Students at UT Austin") would change the natural science requirement of the undergraduate core curriculum.

The proposal was approved by the Faculty Council at its meeting on January 22, 2007. In accordance with our rules, the proposal was circulated to the General Faculty and approved via no-protest vote on February 16, 2007.
