On behalf of Executive Vice President and Provost Steven Leslie, I enclose for your consideration and action a proposed academic catalog change from the College of Education which was approved by the Faculty Council on a no-protest basis on January, 27, 2009, and subsequently approved by the Office of the Executive Vice President and Provost.

- Proposed Mid-Catalog Change to the Bachelor of Science in Applied Learning and Development in the College of Education Chapter of the *Undergraduate Catalog, 2010-2012* (D6797-6801).

There are three changes requested. The first requires all students in the Applied Learning and Development program to fulfill the Natural Science Core Curriculum Parts I and II. This change is related to the Motion to Update from the Core Curriculum Course lists for Natural Sciences Parts I and II (D6802 - D6803) submitted concurrently with this request. The second changes the Early Childhood to Grade Four Generalist major to Early Childhood to Grade Six. This request is to conform to current Texas State Board of Educator Certification requirements. Finally, in compliance with Texas Education Code requirements, the number of semester credit hours has been reduced to 127 for both the Early Childhood to Grade Six and All Level Generic Special Education majors.
