

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS
ON
THE REPORT OF TASK FORCE ON CURRICULAR REFORM

Q. Will the proposed University College take freshman students away from the other colleges?

A. No.

Q. More specifically, will selective colleges be able to admit freshmen?

A. Yes, they will admit freshmen as pre-majors who will be guaranteed major status in the second year. *(See p. 14 of the report.)*

Q. Will students admitted to colleges with a freshman curriculum be able to take major-specific courses?

A. Yes. Colleges may continue to recommend curricula to freshmen. *(See p. 14 of the report.)*

Q. Will University College freshmen be barred from receiving advising and other services in the existing colleges?

A. No. The Task Force recognizes that there are many superb advising programs in the colleges and students will be encouraged to take advantage of them. *(See p. 16 of the report.)*

Q. Will University College threaten major-specific freshman scholarships?

A. No, pre-majors will be eligible for major-specific scholarships.
