 - Identify specific benefit of research to host department and UT Austin.
 - Statement should be understandable to persons who are not expert in the nominee's field(s) of study.
 - Include title for the statement of purpose.
 - Limit length to three typed, single-spaced pages, or six typed, double-spaced pages (12 pt.).
- 4) Three signed letters of recommendation mailed directly to Julie Ewald. Reference "Harrington Fellows Program" on the envelope. Ensure the letters are submitted on time.
