## Driving Directions and Parking:

The 5-story building is located in northeast San Antonio in the cloverleaf intersection of I-35N and Loop 410. All freeway travelers, regardless of direction of travel, should exit on the Randolph Boulevard exit. (For map and detailed directions, see the reverse side of this handout). Free parking is available immediately adjacent to the office.

## Public Transportation:

There are several buses each day that depart from the Greyhound Station at 916 E. Koenig Ln. (next to Highland Mall). To contact the local Greyhound station, call (512) 458-4463. A round trip ticket costs approximately \$22, and it takes approximately 2 hours to reach San Antonio. Once you arrive at the Greyhound Station in downtown San Antonio, you can take a city bus to the San Antonio District Office.

The city bus stop is located at 500 N. St. Mary's St. From there, you can walk to the corner of Commerce St. and Alamo St. and get on bus #15 called VIA Windsor. Do not get on bus #15 that says NE Baptist--that's the wrong bus! It will cost \$.80. You'll ride bus #15 VIA Windsor for approximately 40 minutes to one hour and get off at the Randolph Park & Ride which is the last stop. The San Antonio District Office is located directly across the street. ## Hours and Accessibility:

The San Antonio District Office is open to the public Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM with the exception of Wednesdays (hours on Wednesdays are 8:00 AM - 12:00 PM). The office is closed on Saturday and Sunday and on Federal holidays. The San Antonio District Office is fully accessible to the handicapped and wheelchair-bound.

## Appointment Information:

Effective September 8, 2004, to speak with an Immigration Information Officer, you must schedule an appointment through the *InfoPass* system at [www.uscis.gov](http://www.uscis.gov) (click on *InfoPass* and follow instructions). You must bring the printout of your *InfoPass* appointment and a photo ID with you to the San Antonio District Office.
