**Location** – City of Milan

**Eligibility** -minimum 29 credits. Transfer students not eligible.

**Number of students** - up to four per year.

**Language** - Some courses taught in English (more in the fall than in the spring). Language evaluation online.

**Housing** - Students apply for Bocconi housing or live off-campus. <http://www.isatb.com/html/housing/housing.htm>

**Courses** - must take four courses.

**Credits** – up to 14 credits for the semester (pass/fail).

**Exams** – An early examination period is available for exchange students needing to return to the US by January.

February 18 – June 6, Spring semester
