Eligibility - minimum 29 credits. Transfer students not eligible.

Number of students - up to four per year.

Language - courses taught in French and English. International French Proficiency Test required for French taught classes. Language evaluation online.

Housing - Students apply for Lyon housing.

Courses - must take four courses.

Credits – up to 14 credits for the semester (pass/fail).

Exams – Exchange students are usually allowed to take exams before the holiday break.

January – June, Spring semester

September - First round of UT applications

November - selections

May 1, November 1 - Lyon application deadline
