**Location** – .City of San Sebastian

**Eligibility** - minimum 29 credits. Transfer students not eligible.

**Number of students** - up to four per year.

**Language** – All classes taught in Spanish.  
Language evaluation online.

**Housing** – One men's dorm available and students may stay with a family, otherwise students must obtain their own housing.

**Courses** – must attend full time (5 courses).

**Credits** – up to 14 credits for the semester (pass/fail).

**Exams** – both oral and written exams.
