Eligibility - minimum 29 credits. Transfer students not eligible.

Number of students - up to four per year.

Language - All courses taught in Spanish. Fluency required.
Language evaluation online.

Housing – One men's dorm available and students may stay with a family, otherwise students must obtain their own housing.

Courses – must attend full time - 4 courses.

Credits – up to 14 credits for the semester (pass/fail).

Exams – Two midterms and a final at the end of the program.
