TO ESTABLISH A WIRELESS CONNECTION:

1. Your laptop or other device will need to be equipped with an 802.11b-compatible wireless Ethernet adapter (also called a Wi-Fi compliant).
2. Linksys card users must set the SSID to "guest.utexas.edu".
3. Please **fax to 512-471-6790** or give this sheet to a CSO staff member so your login and password can be established immediately.
4. Once your account is established, you will receive a guest login and password. Open a Web browser such as Netscape or Internet Explorer and you will be automatically directed to the UTNet Public Access Network authentication page.
5. Click on the "Guest/Visitor Login" button. Enter your guest login and password and click on the "Authenticate" button.
6. Your authentication will expire in two hours, but can be reauthenticated at any time during your session.
