If a student takes a postponed examination without permission of the assistant dean, the student will be dropped from the course and the symbol *Q* will be recorded. A student who fails to attend a final examination without the dean's consent may not take a postponed or special examination and will receive no credit for the course; the course will be counted as a course taken and failed when the minimum performance standards are applied and a grade of *F* (1.30 grade points) for the course will be recorded and will be used in calculating the student's grade point average.
