Tarlton Library Renovation Details

As you have been informed via e-mail, there is a new student-administration Jones Hall Renovation Committee. Your student representatives are Michael Raupp, Jason Shippy, and Jess Levy. If you have questions, concerns, or ideas you can e-mail them at their personal e-mail addresses or at libraryrenovation@law.utexas.edu so that all three student representatives will receive your message.

The committee meets bi-weekly so there is regular opportunity to voice your

concerns to the administration and get your questions answered. Renovation and reconstruction will start the day after the last final this fall, so if you have suggestions or concerns, let them know now. They will also need your help in finding areas around the law school to make available for student use during the semester and especially during Spring finals.

Over Winter Break, the fourth floor will be reconfig-

ured and more seating space will be added, to accommodate loss of the fifth and sixth floors. The LexisNexis and Westlaw printers as well as the fifth floor computer area will be temporarily placed on the fourth floor while construction is ongoing, in place of the Media Center. Floorplans will be made available so students can see what the new Jones Hall will look like.
