**COURSE LIMITS**

Students may take no more than two courses during any given period of time. For example, a student may take two first-term courses and two second-term courses, OR two whole-session courses, OR one whole-session course and one first- and/or second-term course. There is no limit on the number of credit hours which may be taken, within the limits stated above.

**FULL-TIME STATUS**

There is no UT Law School nor ABA minimum number of credit hours required for summer. According to the University's Registrar's Office, a law student must take at least 6 hours to be considered full-time and 3 hours to be half-time.
