MENTOR

The mentors are an integral part of the first-year experience at the Law School. They serve as advisors to new students throughout their first year and help them become acclimated to law school.

The mentors help build a strong sense of community among new students. They host academic, social, and athletic activities that bring students together in more personal settings.

The mentors also play an important role in welcoming the first-year law students during the summer before law school begins and host get-togethers prior to orientation.

SOCIETY COORDINATOR
