

## 2006 - 2007 Parking Options for Longhorn Aquatics Members

There have been changes made to the parking regulations as of August 2006. All participants and spectators must have a valid UT permit or park in the garages between the hours of 7:30 AM and 5:45 PM. There are three parking options available between these hours.

### E permits for use on surface lots and the Trinity and Manor Garages – Best Option

The "E" permit may be purchased at the Parking & Transportation Offices in Trinity Garage for **\$88.00** per year. Class "E" permit holders may park from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM in lots signed for Class "E" permits (i.e. - Lot "F11", near Gregory Gym, and on San Jacinto Street near Belmont Hall). This allows parking in the "A" permit spaces behind the swim center after 4 PM. Please be sure to check signage. The E permit is no longer valid in C-Lot 80 between the hours of 4 PM and 5:45 PM. The Class "E" permit is not valid in any "F99", "O", "D", "At All Times", or metered spaces.

By agreement with UT Parking and Transportation, "E" permit holders may park in C lot 80 and will not be ticketed before 8:30 AM but you must have a valid "E" permit. This option is good for morning Masters.

The benefit to the "E" permit is that you may **use your "E" permit as a swipe card to park in the Trinity or Manor garages from 5 AM – 8 PM, including Saturday and Sunday.** The time is being extended to 8 PM to accommodate most of our practice schedules. The garage access makes the "E" permit the best option for all of our swimmers. If the garage is charging up front for a special event, your "E" permit will still allow access between the hours of 5 AM and 8 PM. You must exit the garage by 8 PM!

Please be sure you always swipe your "E" permit both entering and leaving the garage, even if the gates are up. **You must use your "E" to exit,** if you do not, the card will not work when you try to enter the next time. The machine will think you are still in the garage.

A letter authorizing members to obtain the "E" permit is available at the TSC Front Desk. The "E" Permit is **only for members not affiliated with the University** (an employee of the University/Swim Center or a student of the University is not eligible.) **You will have to certify that you fall into this category and will surrender the permit if your status changes.**

To obtain your "E" permit, go to the Parking and Transportation cashier window in the back of Trinity Garage (not the cashier's window at the entrance to the garage).

<b>ALL garage parking is only \$3 for tickets pulled after 5:45 p.m.* until close or midnight at <u>Brazos Garage (BRG).</u> *Additional fees may be charged for some special events. <u>This is a possible option during Basketball games.</u></b>	

- **C Lot 80 Daily \$4.00 scratch-off permits for daytime hours.**

The price of the daily scratch off permit will be **\$4** starting September 1st. This daily scratch off permit is available for use during the day **only in C-Lot 80.** Each permit is only good for one day and the appropriate month and day must be scratched off. **Permits are available for purchase at the Longhorn Aquatics Store during the hours the store is open.** In order for the permit to be valid, it should be displayed on your rear view mirror with your last name written on the permit next to "issue to" and TXLA written next to "issued by". The Longhorn Aquatics store staff should print this for you. You must be sure to scratch off the month and day you want the permit to be valid. **Please be sure your permit is completely filled out or you will be ticketed.**

**The scratch-off permits are not the recommended way to park.** The C lot is a student lot and often full. During home basketball games the lot is closed, only allowing cars with Longhorn Foundation parking permits to enter. During other large special events, the lot may become a paying lot charging a fee.
