



Volunteer Opportunities

Qualifications: Any mother interested in helping and supporting other families. All volunteers will participate in mandatory 8 hour training and are asked to fulfill a one year commitment.

Hospital Visitor

Description: Visit new families on the postpartum unit of area hospitals to offer support and information. Volunteers must be current on immunizations and TB.

Commitment: 2-4 hours per week; may be combined with breastfeeding support caller or parent support caller

Parent Support Caller

Description: From the convenience of home or our office, call families visited in the hospital to offer support, address questions or concerns, give referrals, and invite families to participate in free parenting classes at FamilyConnections.

Commitment: 2-4 hours per week; may be combined with hospital visitor and/or breastfeeding support caller

Breastfeeding Support Caller

Description: From the convenience of home or our office, call breastfeeding moms to offer support, address breastfeeding questions or concerns, and give referrals during the first few months after the baby's birth.

Commitment: 2-4 hours per week; may be combined with hospital visitor and/or parent support caller

Play Group Leader

Description: Parents and babies are invited to attend a morning or afternoon play group. Groups are organized by Play Group Leaders who will lead a discussion on a variety of parenting topics.

Commitment: 2-3 hours per week for 8 weeks

Parent Mentor

Description: From the convenience of home or our office, call a family identified by FamilyConnections as needing more in depth support.

Commitment: 2-4 hours per week

Helping Hand

Description: Assist in the day to day functions of the FamilyConnections Resource Center; tasks include library assistant, data entry, filing, repair and sanitation of toys.

Commitment: 2-4 hours per week
