## About the Program

For the past 56 years, The University of Texas College of Pharmacy has hosted an annual postgraduate pharmacy seminar for pharmacists. During this seminar, there is a Texas Law Update lecture, which updates pharmacists on the most current Texas pharmacy laws and rules set forth by the Board of Pharmacy.
