

# 2011 NEW DRUG UPDATE

Audio Home Study Course



*A knowledge-based CPE activity*

## About the Activity

This course is an audio recording of the New Drug Update lecture from the live Pharmacy Practice Seminar that took place in September, 2011. The New Drug Update informs participants about new medications that have been recently released or are scheduled to be released in the near future. Along with printable presentation slides, the audio-recorded lecture is available via the UTCE website and is accessible online as a self-paced home study course.

## Activity Goal and Objectives

To provide pharmacists and technicians from all practice settings an opportunity to update their knowledge with the most recently released pharmaceuticals. After listening to the lecture and reviewing the presentation slides, the pharmacist should be able to:

- Describe the pharmacology, adverse effects, drug interactions, therapeutic uses and dosing of selected prescription drugs recently marketed.

The technician should be able to:

- Identify the medications recently introduced to the market.

## Activity Format

The materials for this course are posted on the UTCE website and require a password for access. Upon paid course registration, participants will be provided a password and granted access to the materials via the email address provided on the registration form. The materials include the audio-recorded lecture (MP3 file), the printable presentation slides (PDF file) and the Post-test/Evaluation Form (PDF file). The participant must listen to the audio file and review the presentation slides. The presentation slides are printable at the participant's discretion. After reviewing the audio file and presentation slides, the participant must complete the Post-test/Evaluation Form and submit to UTCE for grading. Successful completion of the Post-test/Evaluation Form will result in a statement of continuing education credit.

## Software Requirements

The most recent version of QuickTime and Adobe Reader are needed to access the course materials.
