<p>I. Risk Management Training</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Hazing               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Consent is not a defense</li> <li>-You must report alleged hazing to the Dean of Students; failure to do so can implicate you in the hazing</li> </ul> </li> <li>b. Drug use               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Illegal and recreational drug use is high at UT</li> <li>-Can potentially affect many aspects of an abuser's life</li> <li>-UHS, UT Behavioral Concerns Advice line, Office of the Dean of Students are all possible avenues for reporting suspected drug use</li> </ul> </li> <li>c. Alcohol Abuse               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Do not leave a critically inebriated person alone; help them assume a safe position</li> <li>-The University abides by all state and local statues regarding alcohol use and alcohol use by a minor</li> <li>-AMECH: Alcohol Medical Emergency Call for health emergencies: this service gives immunity from prosecution by the University</li> <li>-Protect your organization legally by: checking IDs, have non-alcoholic options, avoid drinking games, etc.</li> </ul> </li> <li>d. Sexual Assault               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Any undesired and/or unconsented sexual behavior</li> <li>-Alcohol is the most common facilitator of sexual assuault among other drugs such as GHB</li> <li>-Lessen your organization's risk by: fostering a culture that disapproves of alcohol abuse, monitor alcohol distribution, begin and maintain dialogues about these issues, etc.</li> </ul> </li> <li>e. Sexual Harrassment               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Difference between Sexual Harrassment/Sexual Misconduct</li> <li>-Sexual harassment is a widespread issue</li> <li>-Dealing with sexual harassment: confront the offender, report it to a University official, etc.</li> </ul> </li> <li>f. Organization Travel Policies <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-for sponsored and registered student orgs paper work must be filled out for travel more than 25 miles away from campus</li> <li>-approval from an appropriate SALD official or UT administrator is required</li> <li>-Use seat belts, do not consume alcohol while driving, do not exceed carrying capacity of a vehicle</li> <li>-Have valid licenses and registration ready at all times</li> <li>-Practice appropriate emergency management procedures: obtain witnesses, contact advisor, contact Office of Dean of Students, do not express fault, file a police report</li> <li>-When planning events: make sure event is appropriate, control who is invited, designate drivers if alcohol will be served</li> <li>-Avoid prohibited student conduct</li> <li>-Practice proper etiquette</li> </ul> </li> <li>h.
