

SECTION 09720– VINYL-COATED FABRIC WALL COVERINGS
CONSTRUCTION STANDARD

PART 1: GENERAL

1.01 Scope of Standard

- A. This standard provides general guidance concerning the specific preferences of the University of Texas at Austin for site-applied wall finishes of materials such as cork, leather, paper, vinyl, etc., in thin, flexible sheets requiring a supporting substratum.
- B. UT recognizes that project conditions and requirements vary, thus precluding the absolute adherence to the items identified herein in all cases. However, unless there is adequate written justification, it is expected that these guidelines will govern the design and specifications for UT projects.

1.02 Quality Control

- A. Type: Standard use shall be fabric with polyolefin coating, type 2. Use of vinyl coated types is discouraged. Cork and leather are not to be used, and paper may be used only in special locations, such as historic buildings.
- B. Locations: Wall coverings shall be used sparingly, and used only in areas such as Coffee Bars, Break Rooms, etc.

1.03 General Requirements

- A. Asbestos: In no instance will any product containing asbestos be acceptable for use.
