

SECTION 01810 - LEAD ABATEMENT FOR TARGET HOUSING AND CHILD OCCUPIED FACILITIES

CONSTRUCTION STANDARD

PART 1: GENERAL

1.01 Scope of Standard

- A. This standard provides general guidance concerning the specific requirements of The University of Texas at Austin for lead-based paint activity in target housing (includes most single and multifamily dwellings constructed prior to 1978, except dormitory housing and other zero bedroom housing), ~~and~~, and child-occupied facilities (e.g. preschools and daycares) as defined by the Texas Department of Health's Texas Environmental Lead Reduction Rules
- B. It is required that these standards govern the design and specifications for UT projects in these facilities.

- B. Provide a copy of the on-site employee TDH ~~certifications~~, certifications; TDH related training certificates, written respirator protection program, current respirator fit test records, and blood lead level medical evaluations.
- C. Provide copies of daily logs, containment logs, notification, insurance, and all related paper work.
- D. Lead based paint or building material handling and disposal will be in accordance with Section 01800 – Lead Based Paint Removal
