

SECTION 01999 – ASBESTOS ABATEMENT

CONSTRUCTION STANDARD

PART 1: GENERAL

1.01 Scope of Standard

- A. This standard provides general guidance concerning the specific requirements of The University of Texas at Austin for all persons disturbing, removing, encapsulating or enclosing asbestos for any purpose, including repair, renovation, dismantling, demolition, installations or maintenance operations, or any other activity that may involve the disturbance or removal of asbestos containing material whether intentional or unintentional.
- B. It is expected that these standards govern the design and specifications for UT projects.

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1.04 General Requirements

- A. Provide a copy of the asbestos abatement contractor license.
- B. Provide a copy of the on site employees TDH licenses, TDH related training certificate, respirator fit test, asbestos surveillance medical evaluation, and respiratory protection program.
- C. Provide copies of daily logs, containment logs, manifest, notification, and all related asbestos paper work.
