At the request of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Office of Sponsored Projects is hosting Special Agent Gounaud who will discuss the case of Dr. J. Reece Roth, a retired University of Tennessee professor convicted of violating export controls regulations by illegally exporting military information to a citizen of the People's Republic of China.

Sentencing is scheduled for February 18th. Special Agent Gounaud will have the most recent information pertaining to the case.
