

## Texas Quadrangle Grid System

The grid below would extend over a degree of latitude and longitude. The state was divided into one-degree areas beginning in the panhandle, with the northwest-most 1-degree area (or portion of that degree area) numbered 1. The sequence went from west to east to the edge of the state covered by that degree of latitude, then dropped south one degree, again numbering from west to east.
