Biological Hazards and Control

BioSafety Levels

All work with microbiological agents should follow the CDC/NIH guidelines for the appropriate BioSafety Level. At a minimum, research and instructional labs conducting work with microbiological agents should follow the guidelines for BioSafety Level 1 (BSL1). If you are uncertain concerning which biosafety level your work should be considered, call the OEHS Chemical and Laboratory Safety Division at 471-3511 for assistance.
