

Transfer Credit for Students Displaced by Hurricane Katrina

Texas Common Course Numbering System

Courses listed in the attached chart are equated with selected Texas Common Course Numbering System (TCCNS) designations, based on review of descriptions and degree requirements in the most recent available catalogs from the listed universities and community colleges. Students, admission officers, and academic advisors can use this crosswalk as a general guide for transfer credit evaluation and course placement. TCCNS encompasses lower-division academic (in contrast to workforce/technical/vocational) courses designed for university transfer in Texas.

- **For students transferring coursework to a Texas institution:**
courses listed in the crosswalk below are widely applicable at Texas colleges and universities. For example, CHEM 107 at Tulane generally transfers in the same way as CHEM 1311, subject to the transfer practices and curriculum of the receiving institution.
- **For students planning to transfer coursework back to a New Orleans area institution:**
course comparisons listed below are the best available estimates how institutions might accept courses, but Texas campuses cannot guarantee receiving institutions will reciprocate these assessments.
- Differences between courses that may affect transfer and/or degree applicability of credit are noted parenthetically.
