A Career Counselor can help you:

- Explore your values, interests, personality, and skills and relate these traits to majors and careers
- Engage in a thorough discussion of how personal, family and social issues can influence your career planning
- Generate academic major and career options to explore
- Gain access to the wealth of CEC resources (including personality and interest testing, career information, internships, Faculty Contacts, Texas Exes Career Network)
- Learn specific strategies for making decisions, obtaining internships, and applying to graduate school



3 steps to get started:

1. Schedule an appointment by phone or in person
2. Fill out the online Student Information Form (SIF)
 - You may either:
 - Visit our website to complete the online SIF
 - Come in 10-15 minutes before your appt. to complete the online SIF
3. Check in at the Front Desk 5 minutes before your appt.
