1. Send a completed application form.
2. If you are applying to AEP, send proof of a completed undergraduate degree.
3. If you are requesting an I-20 (or DS-2019), send a copy of the photo page of your passport.
4. If you are a NEW AEP/ELP INTENSIVE student requesting an I-20 (or DS-2019), send a financial guarantee statement (usually, a personal/family bank statement), and \$350 USD for SEVIS fee payment, express mail & document processing, and tuition deposit (non-refundable).  
 \*OR\* If you are a PART-TIME or TRANSFER student, send a \$100 USD tuition deposit (non-refundable).

*Photocopies, faxes, or email attachments are acceptable; we do not require original or official documents.  
 If you are applying for an F-1 or J-1 visa, please keep your original financial guarantee statement for your visa interview.*
