

WHAT IS A PEER EDUCATOR?

Peer Educators act as ambassadors for the UT Learning Center by giving workshops on a variety of learning themes, and sharing information about our services. Presentations are made to student associations, to academic classes and in residence halls. Peer Educators also host exhibits at public and campus-wide events.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Present UT Learning Center public relations and direct instruction programs to academic classes, residence halls, student associations, etc.
2. Work individually or with other Peer Educators to design a variety of personalized presentations for programs.
3. Assist in designing and staffing campus-wide exhibits including Longhorn Saturdays, Orientation events, Wellfest, etc.
4. Assist with publicity – in particular the creation of advertising campaigns, brochures, flyers, etc.

PLEASE NOTE: You must have and maintain a GPA of at least 3.0.

This position begins Fall '09 and there will be mandatory training a day or two before classes begin.
