Safety Guidelines

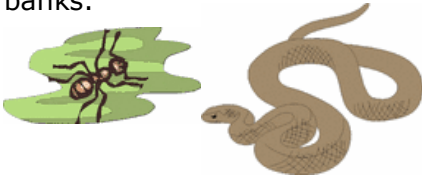
Wear closed-toe shoes or boots that can (and WILL) get wet. There may be broken glass, jagged rocks or other sharp objects. No flip flops!



Wear the gloves provided for you. Protect yourself against cuts, scratches, splinters, and contact with objects that may be contaminated.

Wear long pants. There may be thick brush or poison ivy.

Watch where you step. Stay away from snakes, poison ivy, and fire ants. Be careful around slippery rocks along the banks.



Hydrate yourself. Keep cool and drink plenty of water.



Restrooms will be open in most buildings on campus.

Radio/call the Cleanup coordinators if... you find dead animals or fish, sharp objects like syringes, very heavy objects, or homeless beds or camps.



Shade yourself. A hat, long sleeves, and sunscreen are recommended.
