Membership Requirements

Being a member of ECC is a great way to get involved on campus and develop your leadership abilities. While the Events CoSponsorship Committee does recognize that academics always come first, we would like to stress that every member make ECC a top priority. It is important for each member to be present at *every* meeting and therefore we allow only two unexcused absences a year. ECC requires a greater time commitment than most other organizations. Below you will find an approximate list of how much time you will be spending a week on ECC business.

- ECC meetings are every **Wednesday** at **6:30pm** and last about **two hours**.
- Each member holds an office that will require about **two hours** of work a week.
- Members will serve as contacts for the organizations we fund. Meeting and communicating with the organizations takes about **an hour each week** (though this varies depending on how many contacts you have in a given week).
- At the end of each semester, two to three days of one week will be set aside for early allocations. These meetings will be held in the evening around 6:30pm and will usually last about **three and a half hours per night**.

ECC wants to make it clear that joining this committee is a significant responsibility and a sizable amount of work is expected of its members. However, we also want to emphasize that ECC is a great leadership experience and can also be a lot of FUN! Beyond the work, joining the Events CoSponsorship Committee is a wonderful learning experience and a great opportunity to make new friends.
